MDCP programs in the public services industry sector are in either Public Safety with a Law Enforcement focus or in Emergency Response with a Firefighting and Emergency Medical Services focus. Students in these programs learn industry standard practices, skills, and equipment and are prepared to enter into postsecondary programs that will further prepare them for positions within departments and other service agencies.

Students conduct extensive simulation training and debrief procedures to develop teamwork and leadership competencies and best practices. Students learn about the interoperability and coordination of agencies. Law Enforcement programs include coverage of a variety of services including law enforcement agencies, homeland and cyber security services, and correctional services. Emergency Response programs include deep exploration and skill development within the fire services, emergency medical services, wildland services, and emergency management.

Many students across all these programs also participate in Law Enforcement and Firefighting Explorer programs.
